### **MEMBERSHIP and SHALOM SUNDAY FEES and TUITION**

Annual membership, per household: Membership dues enable SJC to provide a diverse schedule of programs and activities for our community. Membership entitles members to all community activities as well as reduced cost tickets at Rosh Hashanah and Passover events, bi-monthly newsletter, member directory, ritual and lifecycle ceremony support, social groups and adult and student education. SJC strongly encourages households with more than one adult to join the "two adult" category. It is our hope that both adults will be involved to support SJC and each other.

SJC is an affiliate of a national organization: The Society for Humanistic Judaism. SJC membership dues include membership in SHJ. Each member receives the SHJ newsletter, quarterly journal, and access to educational materials, databases, conferences and courses offered by the International Institute for Secular Humanistic Judaism.

Timely payments better enable our community to provide expected services, education and programming. Please help us by communicating payment change requests **on or before the date payment is due** and SJC will try to make accommodations on an individual basis. Please contact SJC if a reduced fee payment plan is needed. <u>No one will be turned away due to limited income or inability to pay.</u>

To participate in the B'nai Mitzvah program, students must be registered for Shalom Sunday. SJC believes everyone should have access to Jewish education.
